



Zeus Rebel Waters is an American hip hop artist/song writer with a distinct sound. Building his supporters, which he calls “The Rebels” on fan at a time, the St. Louis native has been on the grind from an early age. Zeus began preparing for his career in the fifth grade. The young performer got his first taste of stardom when he joined forces with his cousin and best-friend to sing and dance in local talent shows. In middle school Zeus, know then as Rukapuff, formed his rap group P.O.G (Pimped Out Gangsters). The group reached local success producing parties, concerts, and making out0of-state- appearances.

Following the group, the young rap-preneur pursued a solo career. The streets went crazy with the release of his debut single “Angry” which went into full rotation on Q95.5 (Radio One) in St. Louis. Along with the heavy club play throughout the bi-state metro region it wasn’t long before other stations also picked up the song. During his solo rise, the husky-voiced rapper caught the attention of legendary West Coast rapper Mack 10. Mack was immediately taken with Zeus’ music, energy, and stage presence, resulting in him signing the rapper to Hoo Banging Records. Pushed by Mack, the single “Like This” from the album Escaped Off The Chains, was well received with placement in TV commercials, NFL games, the Rogue Pictures film Waist Deep, and the hit drama series The Sopranos.

Ruka continued touring and building his fan base following the Hoo Banging contract. It’s was during this time the artist’s alter ego – Zeus Rebel Waters, was born. Waters’ sound and style evolved into what the deity rapper calls Gumbo – a mixture of all genres, making Zeus’ one of the most exciting live shows. With multiple projects released to date. Da New Lou Mixtape 1-3, Escape Off the Chains, Gunn and Roses, End of Day, I’m a Star, Personality Crisis, F##k the Internet, Grind or Die the Movie, Meet The Rebels, and many more collaborative mixtapes – the Rebel rapper has already began to leave his mark on the music industry.

However, Zeus’ imprint goes far beyond his melodic bars and fire tracks. The eclectic rapper has proven to be an effective and capable business leader owning his own record label, BORN READY RECORDS, launching a clothing line, Rebel Waters Collection, also venturing into film with Trinity Films, and organizing a community-based non-profit for inner city youth called Rock the Community.

Masterfully wearing titles of artist, father, philanthropist, visionary, song and film writer make no mistake Zeus Rebel Waters is a force!
